Enter your first & last name, registration code (tenant code on your move-in form) and email address. HUNT Resident App allows you to submit & track requests. Please contact our office if you have any trouble setting up your account. We are happy to assist you with getting it set up! If you have an Emergency or Urgent service request, please call maintenance as soon as an issue is detected so that we can be proactive in taking care of your family.

Maintenance Tip:

Cease the Grease– Maxwell AFB Grease Recycling Program.

The used cooking oils and grease should be collected in sealed containers, turned in and recycled. So just by pouring your used yellow oil in a container after cooking you've started a process that's good for the sanitary system, your own sanitary pipes, the air, and the environment as a whole. This recycling process can eventually be turned into cleaner fuel!
